Sabra Lynn Hambleton, age 78, of St. Augustine, passed away on January 9, 2019 at Kindred Hospital of N. Florida, with her family at her side. Born to Rankin and Mary Jo Hooks on September 17, 1940 in Macon, GA, Sabra grew up in Jacksonville, graduating from Landon High School with the class of 1958. As a high school student Sabra entered and won a National Betty Crocker Essay contest and was awarded a partial scholarship to attend Florida State University. She graduated from FSU with a Bachelor Degree in English. Sabra met her husband-to-be, Harvey Jay Hambleton, while she was a student at FSU. They were married in Jacksonville, FL, on August 11, 1962, and settled down in Amherst, NY, where she raised a family of three children. Sabra worked for many years in the banking industry for Key Bank and Big E. Bank in Amherst, NY, before relocating to St. Augustine in 1991. She continued her career in banking working for Barnett Bank and also worked for Hampton Inn at St. Augustine Beach for 10 years, retiring in 2010. Sabra loved to play scratch-off lottery and she was an avid collector of toy action figures. She enjoyed watching college football, following her alma mater, FSU Seminoles, watching TV in general, and grocery shopping at Publix. Above all, she loved her family and cherished spending time with them. She will be deeply missed.

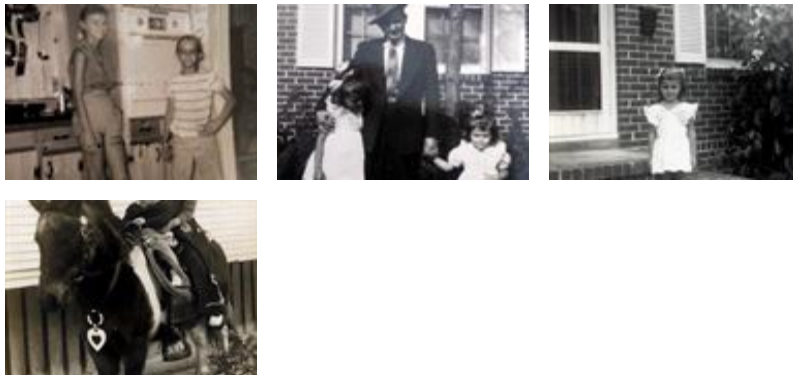
