January 9, 1951 - May 31, 2023

Born in Eden, North Carolina, Sandy was raised in Greensboro and lived in both Kernersville and Gastonia. her church youth ministry and her daughters' school offices. Through prayer she lifted up every person she encountered, actively living her faith in public and private.
