Sara Watson "Sally" Murphy, age 91, of Palm Coast, passed away peacefully on August 14, 2016 at the Windsor of Palm Coast Assisted Living Facility with her family by her side. She was born and grew up in Indiana, Pa. and graduated from Indiana High School. She attended Indiana State Teachers College of Pennsylvania. At the outset of W.W. II, she left college to move to Washington, D.C. with her younger sister to do what they could to assist in the war effort. She worked for the Dept. of the Interior in Washington. She later married William Thomas Murphy after he returned from serving with the U.S. Navy in the Pacific Theater. The couple settled in Buffalo, New York where Sally raised her two children.
