Sardie Cashwell Jones, 101, St. Augustine, passed away December 21, 2017 at the Moultrie Creek Nursing and Rehab Center. Sardie was born on Aug. 5, 1916 in Covington, VA, daughter of the late Saint James and Virginia Cashwell. They moved to Marlinton, West Virginia where she was educated. After graduation, Sardie moved to Washington, D.C. Her first job was in private school for the daughters of diplomats. She also took nursing courses during WW II and went to work for the U.S. Government. She worked 35 years for the federal government. She retired in 1971. During the time in the federal government she worked Army Map Service, Census Bureau, and the Bureau of Mines. During WW II Sardie volunteered with the American Cross and the USO. After retiring Sardie and her husband moved to St. Augustine. Sardie is survived by her two daughters, Gloria Furcron of Ohio and Valernetta Brown of Maryland. Sardie has five grandchildren, nine great grandchildren and eleven great great grandchildren. Sardie was preceded in death by her beloved husband Cornelius Jones.
