

Scott Harvey Ferris

September 24, 1953 - June 13, 2020

Scott Harvey Ferris, age 66, of St. Augustine, passed away on June 13, 2020 at Kindred Hospital of N. Florida. He was born to Alfred and Gloria (Fitzenburger) Ferris on September 24, 1953 and was raised in St. Paul, Minnesota. He was a 1971 graduate of Harding High School and later graduated from Dakota Technical School. At the age of 21, Scott joined the US Navy. He served on several naval vessels including duty post aboard the USS Coral Seas in the Persian Gulf and a naval tug boat in San Francisco. Scott also worked for 3M for 14 years in Minnesota. He met his wife to be, Beverly Brown, in Minneapolis and married her on February 2, 2002. Scott assisted his wife in operating a bed and breakfast in Kewaunee, Wisconsin in the early 2000's and worked as a landscaper for several years. He moved to Palm Coast in 2013 and had been a resident of St. Augustine since 2018. He was a member of the Lutheran Church. He was a loving husband, father, grandpa, brother and friend and he will be deeply missed.

He was preceded in death by a brother Bruce, and a sister Debbie. He is survived by his wife of 18 years, Beverly Brown of St. Augustine; a daughter, Sandy Lee of Tracy, California; brothers, Keith Ronald Ferris of Zimmerman, Minnesota; Kevin Ferris of San Diego, California; a sister, Stevie Ferris of Evans, Colorado; and his beloved grandson, Caleb Scott Lee of Tracy, California.

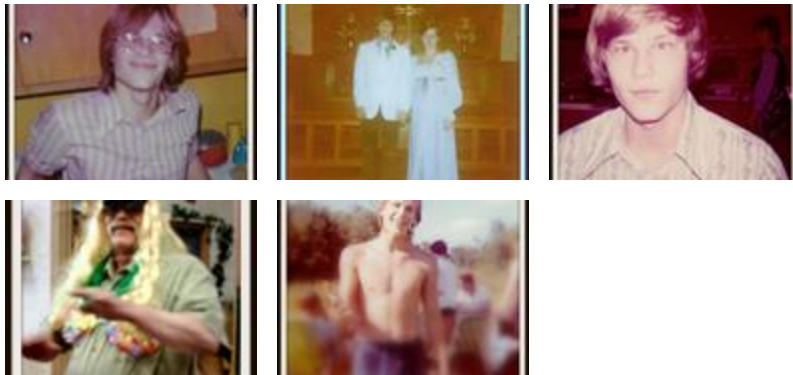
