“ Shannon Carlene Taylor came into the Taylor family on a sunny day in January 1969. The news came to me as I was in the hospital cafeteria at Baptist Hospital in Winston Salem. She was the first grandchild of Blanche and Julian Taylor and the first granddaughter in a family of what to that point was all boys since 1944.

Blanche and Julian came to be called Granny and Pop. It was through Uncle Jimmy, Shannon and Kelly that my own children Hinton, Anna & Margaret came to call them Granny and Pop as well. Jerrie and my children remember Shannon as a very rosy cheeked little girl who came to have a hardy, deep throated laugh during which she would redden deeply in the face.

Hinton writes that he remembers Shannon referring to Granny in a variety of tones, "angry, mocking, and happy". Hinton also writes of remembering a trip Jimmy & Shannon took in the MGB-JET after which they were very sunburned.

Shannon was very attentive to Granny and Pop in their illnesses and last days.

She was also a very concerned daughter during Jimmy's illness and death. We were happy to have Shannon and Kelly at Margaret and Jason's wedding.

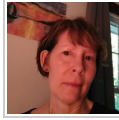
Sadly we lost track of Shannon after the deaths of Granny, Pop and Jimmy.

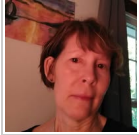
