Shawn Allen Hagene, age 18, of Hastings, died on June 8, 2012 from injuries sustained in an automobile accident. He was born in Jacksonville but had lived in St. Johns County most of life and had recently graduated from Pedro Menendez High School on June 2. He was well thought of by his peers and teachers at Pedro Menendez and was active in community projects, including rebuilding lifeguard towers for Vilano Beach and sheds for Habitat for Humanity. His longtime passion, however, was tinkering with go carts, dirt bikes and trucks. Shawn enjoyed his part time job working at Five Guys Restaurant but aspired to become a mechanic. In 2007, Shawn was awarded an Outstanding Public Service Award by St. Johns County Fire Rescue for his bravery in saving a woman who had been in an auto accident.
