Simon Philip Hanley died peacefully on April 13, 2016 surrounded by his loving wife Mary Frances of 60 years and children. Born and raised in The Bronx to Simon Patrick and Sallie (Shevlin) Hanley. Attended Cathedral College NY., St. Mary's, Louisville KY., St. Michael's College, Winooski, VT., St. Joseph's, Dunwoodie, NY., Fordham University, Brooklyn Law School and NYU (Masters). Served in the US ARMY from 1950-1953 including participation in OPERATION BLUEJAY in Thule Bay, Greenland with the 373th Major Port Operation and in 1951 deployed to Korea as replacement in the 25th Infantry Div. and later reassigned with the 101st Signal Corps., Communications Support – IX Corps., Korea (Chunchon Area). Employed with the FBI, New York and Monsanto Company, Textile Div. for 26 years as Marketing Manager, Northern and West Coast, Fiber and Yarn. Subsequently, formed SI-TEX Inc. Import/Export Textile Fibers/Yarns. Si and Mary Frances retired to St. Augustine, FL in 1991 and became parishioners of St. Anastasia R.C. Church. Si was a 3rd degree Knight of Columbus Council 7121 and 4th degree Knight of Columbus, Bishop Verot Assembly, 0166 and a member of the Eucharistic Adoration Adores at St. Anastasia Church. Memorial services will be held at St. Anastasia Catholic Church on Monday April 18, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. Inurnment will take place at St. Anastasia Catholic Church at a later date. St. Johns Family Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
