Sophia Joyce Fink, age 15 of Saint Augustine, FL, passed away on January 22, 2026, at her beloved school, Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind (FSDB).

She was born on April 5, 2010, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to parents Robert Van Fink III & Rachel Martin Fink. She was a freshman at FSDB, where she had been a student since kindergarten. Sophia is preceded in death by paternal grandfather, Robert "Boompa" Fink. Survived by her parents, her older sister Hannah, and her younger siblings Mary, Robert "Ace", Lydia, Martin, and Faith, all of St. Augustine; paternal grandmother, Bridggette Fink; maternal grandparents Bob & Joyce Martin, 14 aunts and uncles, 19 cousins, and innumerable friends.

Sophia had a caring heart and loved to help people. She aspired to become a doctor or work in the medical field. She admired first responders and would say a prayer every time she heard an emergency vehicle. One of her proudest accomplishments was earning her Red Cross First Aid Certification.

Sophia's greatest joy was her time spent at FSDB. She grew up at FSDB and considered it her second home. She loved dearly every classmate, teacher, and staff member. Every time someone had a birthday, she would ask to get them a gift or make them a card. If a classmate was sad, mad, or scared, she

would encourage them with a smile, a joke, or a big lift-you-off-the-ground hug. She loved to make people feel better and make them laugh.

Sophia's hobbies included jigsaw puzzles (which she put together upside down), large print word searches, crossword puzzles, cryptogram puzzles, researching tornadoes and tornado sirens, UNO, playing games with her siblings, baking with mommy (she liked to add extra special ingredients), and riding roller coasters with daddy.

Sophia will be remembered for her loud, exuberant voice, her laughter, and her confidence.

Funeral services will be held at 11:30 a.m. on Friday, January 30, 2026, at the main sanctuary at Chapel Turning Point at Calvary Church, 3500 State Road 16 in St. Augustine. The family will receive friends at the chapel from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Entombment will take place in the church mausoleum.

I don't know if you will remember me, but my name is Savannah. I had the privilege of working with your daughter afterschool in the dorm program at FSDB. I would like to share one of my favorite memories of Sophia.

One year for Valentine's Day, a dorm staff in the middle school made a construction paper tree decoration with construction paper hearts that students could glue on as leaves. Each student was to write the name of the person that they loved and tape the heart to the tree. Most kids gave pretty typical answers. They loved their family, their dog, or (because it's middle school) they teased each other about which boy they liked. But then there was Sophia. For fifteen minutes or so, Sophia paced up and down in the main student sitting area and (in her usual exuberant Sophia way) listed every single family member or friend that she could think of. (If you are a cousin, aunt, or uncle of Sophia's reading this, I can assure you that you were definitely specifically named. This sweet girl included the names of people she hadn't seen since she was three.) I say this to highlight the true light and joy that Sophia brought with her everywhere she went. Truly the light of Christ's love and joy shone greatly through Sophia Joyce Fink. To Mr. and Mrs. Fink and Sophia's siblings and family, I pray that God gives you comfort during this time. I pray that even amidst the bitter sadness that you would find peace, hope, and strength in knowing that Sophia went home to the only Person who can heal all of her pain and make her new and whole and that you will see her again someday. I thank Jesus that His victory means that we have hope in life and in death. I pray that you and 'your family would be loved and comforted and strengthened by the God who heals all things, knows all things, and works all things for good. Your daughter (or sister or relative or friend) was a beautiful beacon of Christ's love, joy, and service to all those that she met. I pray that her life and legacy will not be forgotten.

“ Sophia first came to us in the FSDB OT/PT department in September of 2015. She was a happy, spunky, and adorable kindergartner who was already brandishing her permanent front teeth.

Over time, Sophia endeared herself to our entire department, and we looked forward to her weekly visits. Her favorite expression, “But that’s okay”, became a beloved Sophia-ism, and was, it seemed, her signature way of normalizing imperfection; by putting a positive spin on shortcomings, whether her own, or someone else’s. She’d exclaim, “Oh I messed up. I colored outside the lines...”(then nod reassuringly while smiling broadly and stating confidently) “but that’s okay!” It was part of her superpower—giving herself and others the space and grace to make mistakes without losing their value. This was just one of the Sophia pearls I snatched and hid in my heart.

Another, was her caring spirit—her genuine concern for the wellbeing of others, which, for us was often manifested by Sophia taking care of the younger students on the golf cart to and from therapy. In alignment with this caring nature was Sophia’s aspirations to become a doctor or medical professional, remained consistent throughout the years. What began with an admiration for Doc McStuffins, grew into awe and fascination for the *Untold Stories of the ER*. She would often tote her library book to therapy to share her new medical findings with us—Like when she discovered that there were two types of lobes on our bodies: in our ears and in our brain—she was so excited to share!

So often I would be caught off-guard at the profoundness of her thoughts, delivered Sophia-style...with a cadence that held you in suspense until just past the closed eye interval, when the fullness of her thoughts came pouring out. This is another unique Sophia-ism that I will so miss.

Sophia made every effort to live her faith out loud. She was not

about hiding her not-so-little light under a bushel, or any other covering. Her convictions were expressed with the same zeal and at the same volume as her other communications. I admired that about her.

I count myself blessed to have had Sophia in my life . And I can honestly say that I am a better person for having known her. In her honor I will aspire to treat others with more gentleness, authenticity and acceptance.

She was a beautiful soul who was so easy to love. I believe that sometimes unbeknownst to us, we entertain angels here on earth without knowing. I think Sophia was one of those. And I am quite certain that she is VERY excited about her beautiful new wings right about now. ☐💔❤️☐❤️ I will think of her often and miss her forever!

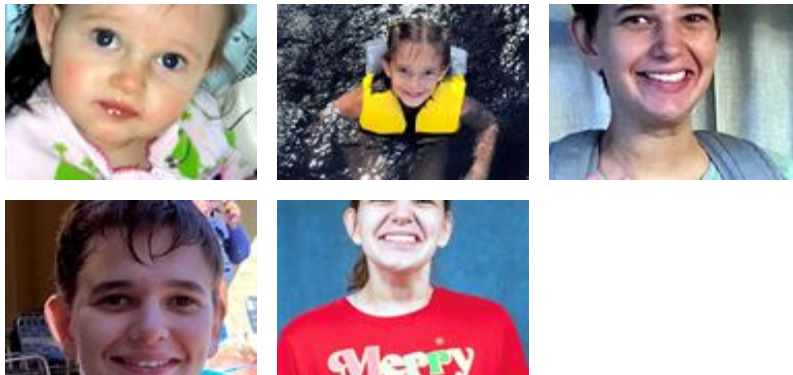

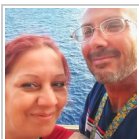

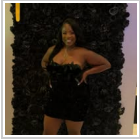
