



Stephen Shouse

June 8, 1951 - May 4, 2020

Mr. Stephen Shouse passed away on May 4, 2020, in St. Augustine, FL after a battle with cancer. Stephen was born June 8, 1951 in Portsmouth New Hampshire and graduated from Portsmouth High School. After high school Stephen served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. Following his discharge from the Army Stephen returned to his home town and began a career as a machinist at Portsmouth Naval Shipyard where he remained until transferring to Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay. Stephen served as a supervisor in Shop 31 of the Trident Refit Facility until his retirement. Following retirement Stephen began his next, and favorite career, as Papa to four grandchildren. He returned to Portsmouth to be closer to his brothers and sisters. He remained in Portsmouth until he was moved back to Florida to be with his sons and grandchildren, in his final months, however Portsmouth never left his heart. Stephen enjoyed working on cars, going for a drive “breezing in and out”, spending time with family, and strolling through Market Square.

Stephen is survived by his two sons Matt (Amanda) Shouse, of Macclenny, FL, and Jeff (Jessica) Shouse, of St. Augustine, FL, and four grandchildren Mattisyn, Landyn, Camryn, and Connor.
