Susan Elin Winkler ((Pulli) died of natural causes at her home in St. Augustine, Florida on February 27, 2024.

Susi was born to Ruth (Hellman) and Nils Pulli in The Bronx in New York. Until the age of seven, she grew up in Manhattan, New York. Her father died when she was seven and the family later relocated to the Brookfield areas in Massachusetts.

Susi graduated from David Prouty High School in Spencer, Massachusetts. After high school, she attended Quinsigamond Community College in Worcester, Massachusetts and moved to Florida. She lived in the Broward County area for several years before moving to St. Augustine. She continued her education at Broward Community College and Florida Atlantic University. Susan enjoyed her work in the business, legal and accounting fields. She also established and co-owned legal and accounting businesses in the 1980s and 1990s in south Florida.

In 1974, Susi married the love of her life, Jerry Winkler, whom she met while they were waiting in line at the meat counter in a grocery store. They enjoyed traveling the world together and visited most of the United States, Canada, China and Europe.

After Jerry's debilitating stroke in 2000, Susi devoted herself towards his care. They remained married until Jerry's death in 2016.

Susi was tireless in her professional work and caregiving for her family and close friends. She was a lot of fun; a joyous person with a kind heart who

embraced life with vigor.

Susi is predeceased by her husband, Jerry Winkler, father, Nils Pulli, mother, Ruth Holmgren, sisters, Linda Castano, Mary Stabler and Barbara Newman and brother, John Holmgren.
