Theodore Pappas, 93, of St. Augustine, Florida, passed away on November 7, 2024, at his home. Born on March 28, 1931, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, he was the son of Greek immigrants and grew up in the heart of the Midwest.

He was an active member of the St. Augustine Camera Club, where he shared his expertise, mentored fellow photographers, and nurtured his own creative spirit. His keen eye for detail and ability to capture the world through a lens were hallmarks of his work.

Ted is survived by his beloved wife, Joan; sons Michael (Theresa) and Gregory (Aetan); and grandson, Miles. He was also cherished by many extended family members and friends, all of whom will remember his warmth, generosity, and the joy he brought to those around him.
