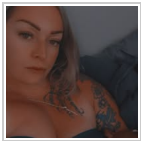

“ It is hard to grasp and realize that our loved ones have gone. But only God knows our time, and when He will call us home. Tommy was born in Hialeah 19th January 1964 to his mom Karen Leigh Merkey Porter, and I, James Blair Porter, Jr.

I was serving in the US Air Force at Greenham Common Royal Air Force Base, in England. Tom, his brother Bub (Jim), and Karen, my wife joined me to live in England after Tom was born.

When Tom was two years old, we moved back to Hialeah, across the street from Bigdaddy and Momo's house. We had many family gatherings and holidays dinners. Brother Randy and his family, sister Susie and her family, aunt Sarah and her family, all lived close by in Hialeah and spent a lot of family time together at Momo and Bigdaddy's house.

Later, as we moved apart, we would visit frequently for family gatherings.

I suppose that's why Tommy never met a stranger and always wanted to help those who had a need. He was patient sole and would always find the good in people.

In his last days in hospital, we asked Tom the 2 Evangelism Explosion questions: if you died today, do you know you would go to Heaven? Tom said Yes. What would you say when God asked you: Why should I let you into my Heaven? Tom said I tried to be a good person and obey God's commands. We explained no one can be good enough, it's only by you accepting Jesus that you are saved. Just to be sure he was right with Jesus. We felt that Tom did understand what was said and he had made the decision to ask Jesus into his life.
