Thomas Paul "Tom" Zambrano, age 84, of St. Augustine, passed away on Saturday, Feb. 28, 2015 at Flagler Hospital with his family by his side. He was born and grew up in Brooklyn, New York and served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. After his discharge from the Army, he returned to New York and owned and operated his own masonry business. In 1959, he joined the NYC Fire Department and served at stations in Brooklyn, Manhattan and the Bronx for 19 years, retiring after sustaining an injury on the job. Tom embarked on a second career as an author and inventor, publishing a book titled "Warriors of Fire" based on some of the experiences of his career. He had been a resident of St. Augustine since 1978. More than anything, he was a loving husband, father, brother, grandfather and great grandfather, and will be deeply missed. He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Gloria Zambrano of St. Augustine, daughters, Donna Brown (Dennis) of Georgia, Lori Roberts (Daniel) of Jacksonville; sons, Tom Zambrano, Jr. and John Zambrano (Jennifer), both of St. Augustine; a brother, Matty Zambrano of New York, 7 grandchildren, and 6 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a daughter, Debra Johnson. A memorial gathering of family and friends will be held from 2 to 4 pm on Thursday at St. Johns Family Funeral Home.
