Timothy M. Kelly, 65, of Saint Augustine, FL, passed away on Sunday, November 24, 2024, at his home following a short period of illness.

Timothy was born on November 7, 1959, in Canton, OH, to the late Albert and Martha Jane VonHantlemann Kelly. He spent his childhood in Canton before moving to Wooster, OH, where he attended the Ohio State Agricultural Technical Institute, receiving his associate degree in agriculture in 1980. In Walterboro, he was an active member of the community, serving as a board member of the South Carolina Artisans Center and contributing to its capital campaign committee.
