Trevor Scott Gilbert, 20, of St Augustine, Florida passed away at his residence surrounded by family and friends on March 29, 2021 following a 6-year battle with Childhood Brain Cancer. Trevor would like it known that he battled Childhood Brain Cancer to bring awareness to this disease in hopes that further awareness would spur support and research to end this disease. Trevor was born on October 17, 2000 in Ft. Wayne, Indiana to John R. Gilbert and Kimberly S. Herbert.

Trevor was a kind young man who loved all people. He was a champion for those less fortunate and valued people regardless of their race, religious beliefs, disabilities, or sexual preference. He genuinely wanted to see equality for all people and was an outspoken advocate for those he felt were being slighted. Trevor loved fast cars and was proud of his Chevy Impala. He was a fan of dinosaurs, Jurassic Park, Star Wars and Hard Rock music. He never met a stranger and brightened the day for those he encountered everywhere he went.

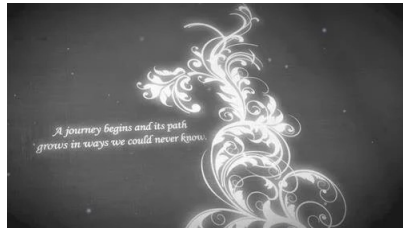

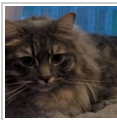

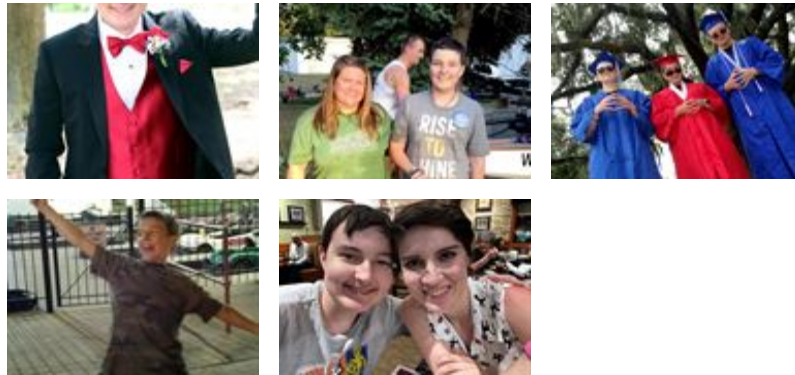
