Veronica (Vonnie) Rose Daniels Lowe passed away on Friday, December 30, 2022. Vonnie was born on February 10, 1938, to Emogene Curlee Daniels and Cardell "Cracker" Daniels. She attended Florida State University and began a career as a registered nurse. In 1957 she married Joseph Calvin Lowe; Joe was the love of her life and her high school sweetheart.
