Pastor Walter L. "Mike" Busby, age 81, of St. Augustine passed away at Flagler Hospital on Monday, June 5, 2017. He was born to Walter and Texie "Fatherbee" Busby in Mobile, AL on April 27, 1936. Mr. Busby moved to St. Augustine from the Miami area in 1970. He then began to serve as a Lutheran missionary to the deaf at the Florida School for the Deaf and Blind. For many years he was a fixture at FSDB as well in the deaf community at large. Pastor Busby's heart and life were in the deaf community. Generations of students loved and respected him. In later years, he helped to start the congregation at Christ Our Savior Evangelical Lutheran Church on Milton Street in St. Augustine. He retired as the pastor from "Our Savior" in 2006. Pastor Busby will always be remembered as a kind, generous, loyal man who very loved and will be sorely missed by many. He was preceded in death by his son, Marco Busby; his parents; and brother, Jack Busby. Survivors include, daughter, Katie (Randy) Smith; son, Mike (Bel) Busby; son, Andrew Busby as well as 8 grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; along with his nieces and nephews.
