William R. "Bill" Buzzi, age 57, of St. Augustine, passed away peacefully on Saturday, Oct 6, at his home surrounded by his family. He was born and grew up in Torrington, Connecticut, the son of Albina Buzzi and the late Robert Buzzi. He was a graduate of Washington State University with a BS in Biology, earned an MS in Marine Biology from the College of Charleston, and a Ph.D. in Molecular Biology from the University of South Carolina. For many years he worked for The Whitney Laboratory for Marine Bioscience where served as the Education Coordinator. Most recently he served as Director of Research and Development for Carr Specialty Baits. Bill was a fascinating man. Though he rarely wore anything but blue jeans and t shirts, he loved jazz, opera, folk music, politics, kayaking, fishing and literature. He was a talented and accomplished chef.
