William Arnold "Bill" Laursen, age 85, of the Coquina Crossing community in Elkton, died on October 25, 2009 in Saint Augustine. Bill served his country in U.S. Navy during W.W. II. in the Asiatic and Pacific theaters. After returning to civilian life, Bill began working for Chrysler Corporation. He was preceded in death by his parents, Arnold & Marie Laursen, a brother, Duane Laursen, and a sister, Delphine Laursen Campbell.
