William (Bill) S. Miller, 99, Palm Coast, formerly of Media, PA, died November 19, 2022 at the Stuart F. Meyer Hospice House. He was born September 27, 1923 in Chester, PA and had resided in St Augustine for several years before moving to Palm Coast. He was a veteran of the Merchant Marines having served during WW II. Bill was graduated from Drexel University with a degree in Engineering which he applied throughout his career in the chemical and petroleum industry. He retired from Sun Oil Company in 1983. Bill was a gifted water colorist and a small plane pilot. In addition he enjoyed RVing around the states, fishing, birdwatching, carpentry and refinishing furniture. He served 10 years as a Docent at the St. Augustine Lighthouse and he received the Senior Volunteer of the year award in 2006 for his work at the Lighthouse.

He is survived by Grace, his wife of 31 years. Prior to his marriage with Grace, Bill was a widower (Betty Hanna Miller deceased 1985) and is survived by their children Barbara Ryder, Dale Miller, Dane Miller and Laurie Rendin.
