William Jennings Bryan Moore, Jr. known by friends and family as “Dub” or “WJ” passed away on November 28, 2020 at the Stuart Meyer Hospice House in Palm Coast, Florida. WJ was born November 13, 1930 in Burlington, NC to William Jennings Bryan Moore, Sr. and Mattie Bell (Foreman) Moore.

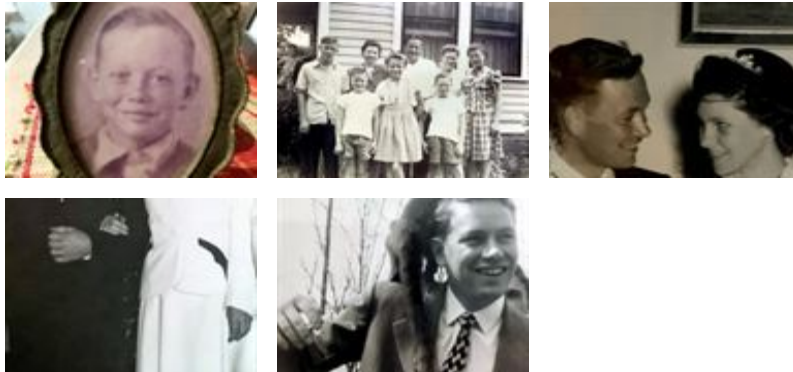
