William Liles "Bill" Williams Jr, 73 of Hastings, Florida passed away peacefully at St. Vincent's Medical Center Southside in Jacksonville on May 19, 2023.

Bill was born on October 3, 1949, in Jacksonville, Florida to Jeanne and W.L. "Bill" Williams Sr. In 1968, he followed in his father's footsteps and enlisted in the United States Navy. After serving his country, Bill's life was a colorful combination of all things Harley-Davidson motorcycles, off-shore fishing, running a pest control business, and English Springer Spaniels.

Bill spent 42 years as the owner and operator of St. Augustine Service Inc. a family-owned pest control company originally started by his father in Orange Park. Bill was very fortunate to have had many immediate and extended family members and friends surrounding him in his 73 years of life.
