W. H. "Mac" McIntire, age 79, passed away on August 22, 2010, at Shands Hospital in Jacksonville. Mr. McIntire was born in Denver Colorado and has resided in Coquina Crossing, St Augustine, since July 1999. He was a member of Old Moultrie Baptist Church, St. Augustine; Liberty Lodge number 150 A.F. & A.M., Denver, Colorado; The Scottish Rite Freemasonry, Pensacola; The Retired Officers Association, St. Augustine and Washington D.C.; American Association of Retired Persons, and was a Commander, Retired, U.S. Navy. CDR McIntire entered the U.S. Navy as an enlisted man in 1950 and was commissioned a Naval Aviator in 1956. He was a graduate of the University of Southern California Aviation Safety School, Naval War College and George Washington University. He served during Korea and two tours in Vietnam as well as serving in many aircraft squadrons and carriers, taking him to Hawaii, Hong Kong, Japan, Okinawa, Thailand, Australia, and the Philippines. Upon his retirement from the U.S. Navy, he was employed in banking, credit accounting and numerous part time employments. He was very active in the Coquina Crossing community. He was preceded in death by his wife of 51 years, Barbara Fiveash McIntire. Survivors include his two daughters, Cynthea A. Carlton and her husband Carroll of Chesapeake, VA, Vanessa A. Cubilla and her husband Paul of Jacksonville FL; four grandchildren, Ashley and Logan of Jacksonville FL, and Craig and Cody of
